Summerville Writers Guild Liaison Report (Hyatt)

- Once again, it is a joy to report that Summerville Library is participating in the Library Initiative of the South Carolina Academy of Authors. Librarian Rebecca Westfall and Ellen E. Hyatt met on Tuesday, April 1, to place works of the 2014 Inductees in the display case. During the month of April, Summerville Library's display case is hosting displays of works by Inductees Gilbert Allen (poetry); Janette Turner Hospital (fiction); John Lane (nonfiction); and the late Robert Quillen (journalist and single-panel cartoonist).

New Business

- The Nominating Committee Preliminary Report April 8, 2014
Members of Nominating Committee: Harriet Little, Angela Creed, and Autumn Reid.
The Committee recommends the following individual for Treasurer:

- Autumn will look into ordering more bags. Funds for the purchase have been allocated and are in the budget for 2014.
- The Rotary will present a Flag Day program. Each child who attends will be presented with a new book. Proper flag etiquette will highlight the program.
- The Rotary is purchasing a shelf of books on American history, Civics, Government and patriotic holidays for the library.
- The library asked the Rotary to consider purchasing a special display on castors for displaying the books. The donated books would be displayed for a period of time and then the shelf might be used for other purposes such as displaying new books. The total shelf cost is \$1200, the Rotary has \$600 that can be used toward its purchase. The library requested that the Friends complete the purchase at the cost of approximately \$600. Ellen suggested that an engraved plaque be purchased and attached to the shelf acknowledging the gifts. After discussion, Carol moved that FOSL provide funds, not to exceed \$600. Anne moved that a plaque be purchased citing the Rotary and FOSL as benefactors.
