As a non-profit organization, we sponsor library programs, host community programs, raise awareness of the library and its resources, and stimulate gifts.

FOSL membership meetings are held the second Tuesday of each month in the Westvaco Room of the George H. Seago library at 76 Old Trolley Road - next door to Applebee's Restaurant. The meetings begin promptly at 7 pm and usually adjourn at 8 pm.

FOSL volunteers collect, sort and store books all year for resale at one of the three gigantic book sales the Friends sponsor. Some books sell for as little as 50 cents each. DVDs, CDs and Cassette tapes are often available. FOSL members are encouraged to attend the first day of the sale for the best selection. Volunteers working at the sales earn half off the already low priced books they purchase. All the funds raised go to support programs offered by our local library as well as other needed items the library can't squeeze out of its limited budget.

The next gigantic book sale is MAY 2, 3, AND 4, 2014.

Bring your children to the Family Story Hour at 10:30 am every Saturday morning, where a FOSL member reads books to the children.

The Summer Reading Program, the Romance Readers Book Club, and It's a Mystery to Me Book Club are underwritten by FOSL.

Visit us at Third Thursday on the square. Volunteers are found at most Third Thursday and other D.R.E.A.M. events.
