# Membership and Book Sale Report - C. Coffey

### Membership:

One new membership collected in April. Collected 13 renewals. \$185.00 in dues and \$20.00 in donations for a total of \$205.00 turned in at executive board meeting. During the book sale 1 new membership and 10 renewals were collected.

## **Book Sale:**

Collected \$63.74 from Matthew Savage for consignment sales in April. Twenty FOSL members received their discount coupon for books purchased on Friday and Saturday. Gross income from book sale is \$4,532.80. (Thursday-\$238.50, Friday-\$2,299.50, Saturday-\$1,290.30, Sunday-\$704.50. Last year(2016), May sales were \$4,000.60. **Thank you to all the volunteers who made this sale possible!** There were 32 volunteers, several who worked more than one day. A special thank you to Karen Petros and Anne Gleason who do a fantastic job of sorting the books. The weather was great- NO RAIN.
